VocRehab Vermont Announces Time Limited Opportunity for High School Students on IEP/504 Plans

High school students on an IEP or 504 plan who are looking for help preparing for employment and/or college, are invited to participate in a TIME LIMITED opportunity for help with these goals.

[VocRehab Vermont](#) is partnering with high schools all over the state to offer sophomores and juniors who are on IEPs, 504 Plans, or are 504 eligible, a set of 'enhanced' services through the [Linking Learning to Careers \(LLC\)](#) project. LLC provides additional work-based learning, post-secondary exploration, assistive technology, and transportation staffing and resources to enrolled students, in addition to the transition services already provided through VocRehab.

LLC is part of a national research study funded by the US Department of Education, which is offering a very limited time to get students enrolled. All students participating must be enrolled within the next few weeks, after which NO additional students can benefit.
